Remarks 1:

After successful completion of the judging seminar, a certificate will be issued to the participants who passed the exam stipulating the level of qualification – either National or International level 2. The certification will be valid for 2 years until April 3rd 2026.

To be eligible for taking International 2 exam, the participants must have a proof of possession of valid National level certification in EMS (Event Management System).

In order to maintain the judge qualification (valid for 2 years), you are required to judge a minimum of 2 local/ overseas events within 2 consecutive years counting from the date of issuance of the certification. After 2 years you will need to attend the Seminar to refresh your knowledge and confirm your level by passing the exam.

If the seminar is cancelled prior to the start of the seminar, due to bad weather or other circumstances, the entry fee will be refunded to the enrolled participants by cheques, so please provide your full name on the enrolment form.

Applications from members with outstanding payments for past events will not be accepted unless he/she provides payment evidence or settles the outstanding payment.

Only enrolment forms issued by HKCWA & completed by the participant will be accepted, phone registration, or entry forms designed by others will not be accepted.
