Annex 1

Entry Conditions & Administration

All athletes must submit their entries by being registered by their respective <u>Federations</u> in IWWF's <u>Event Management System (EMS)</u>.

a. IWWF's Event Management System (EMS)

IWWF's EMS will be used by the organisers to manage the event. Athletes should request their respective <u>Federations</u> or email <<u>asia@iwwf.sport</u>> if they are UAE citizens/residents or do not belong to any Federation to be registered in EMS accordingly. Example of an athlete's profile on IWWF's EMS: <u>JAEMJAN</u> Padiwat

b. Registration of Athletes Using EMS

Each athlete must register to compete in the **2024 Ras Al Khaimah Waterski & Wakesports Championships** using IWWF's EMS no later than **5**th **May 2024**. An entry is considered complete when an athlete has registered for the event in EMS and full entry fee payment has been received. Entry fee payment must be made by cash before the first day of competition if residing outside the UAE and online upon Registration if residing in the UAE:

The procedure to register for 2024 Ras Al Khaimah Waterski & Wakesports Championships in EMS is as follows:

- 1. Athlete has to login to EMS
- 2. Go to **My Competitions** and Click on "**New participation**" button. Select the appropriate competition from the list. Filter as follows:
 - To compete in **Waterski Slalom** Country: **UAE**

Note: Code 24UAE005

- To compete in **Wakeboard**Country: **UAE**Note Code 24UAE006
- To compete in Wakesurf Country: UAE Note: Code <u>24UAE007</u>
- 3. Select your category and click on **"Submit Participation"** button.

c. ATHLETE INFORMATION FOR COMMENTATOR & MEDIA

Athletes should log into <u>IWWF's EMS</u> to fill in / update their profiles (accomplishments, sponsors, <u>social media handles</u>, other interesting information in the optional fields, etc. so the event commentator has

information easily accesible to communicate to spectators present at the event venue and online via live stream. Athletes should also upload their photos for the media. IMPORTANT: To be able to complete/populate their profiles, the Athletes must be EMS USERS, i.e. they must be invited by their



respective Federations to become EMS users and have accepted this invitation. Athletes should contact their respective <u>Federations</u> if they are not active / confirmed EMS users. Example – click <u>here</u>

ANNEX 4 NOVICE WAKEBOARD TRICK LIST

Trick	Description
Cross One Wake	
Cross Both Wakes	
Surf The Wake	Turn Up & Down Boat Wake (minimum 3 turns linked together at the top of the wake)
Sideslide	Rotate Board 90 Degrees On The Surface Of The Water
Reverse Sideslide (touch water)	Sideslide with Back Towards Boat, One Hand Touching Water
Heelside and Toeside Bunny Hop	Jump Off The Water To Get Air Without Wake
Frontside Lipslide	Toeside Approach & Slide Board 90 Degress On The Crest Of Wake (1 second minimum), with the tail of board going over the wake first, and Chest Facing Boat
Backside Lipslide	Heelside Approach and Slide Board 90 Degrees On The Crest Of Wake (1 sec. min.), with the tail of board going over the wake first, and Back Facing Boat
Frontside Boardslide	Toeside Approach and Slide Board 90 Degrees On The Crest Of Wake (1 sec. min.), with nose of board going over the wake first, and Back Facing Boat
Heelside Powerslide	Rotate Board Backside 90 Degrees in the flats with Back Facing Boat.
Surface 180 (front to fakie)	Rotate Board 180 Degrees On The Surface Of The Water From Front To Fakie Position
Surface 180 (fakie to front)	Rotate Board 180 Degrees On The Surface Of The Water From Fakie To Front Position
Surface 360 (frontside and/or backside rotation)	Rotate Board 360 Degrees On The Surface Of The Water (continuous rotation without stopping)
*Heelside Jump (1 wake)	Use Boat Wake To Get Board In The Air & Out Of The Water
*Toeside Jump (1 wake)	Use Boat Wake To Get Board In The Air And Out Of The Water
*Heelside Jump (2 wakes)	Use Boat Wake To Get Board In The Air And Out Of The Water, Clearing Both Wakes
*Toeside Jump (2 wakes)	Use Boat Wake To Get Board In The Air And Out Of The Water, Clearing Both Wakes
