#### **ANNEXE 2**

#### **ENTRY**

All riders must enter the competition using an official online Entry Form and also register in IWWF's Event Management System (EMS) so they will be scored.

1) Official Entry Form click here

2) IWWF EMS Entry click here

Thai Nationals who do not have an IWWF license should fill out the Official Entry Form first, and TESA will assist with registration.

#### **Entry Conditions & Administration**

All athletes must submit their entries by being registered by their respective Federations in IWWF's Event Management System (EMS).

### a. IWWF's Event Management System (EMS)

IWWF's EMS will be used by the organizers to manage and score the event. Athletes should request their respective <u>Federations</u> to register them in the EMS accordingly.

#### b. Registration of Athletes Using EMS

Each athlete must register to compete in IWWF Asia Wakefest Bangkok 2024 using IWWF's EMS no later than **5**<sup>th</sup> **August 2024**. An entry is considered complete when an athlete has registered for the event in EMS and full entry fee payment has been received. Entry fee payment must be made by cash or bank transfer before official practice.

The procedure to register for IWWF Asia Wakefest Bangkok 2024 in EMS is as follows:

- 1. Athlete has to login to EMS <a href="https://ems.iwwf.sport">https://ems.iwwf.sport</a>
- 2. Go to **My Competitions** and Click on "**New participation**" button. Select the appropriate competition from the list. Filter as follows:
