Individual Entry Requirement

Anyone holding a valid IWWF license (EMS) is eligible to participate.

2. IWWF EMS (Except for Beginner Wakesurf Categories)

Each athlete, except Wakesurf Beginner Category, must register to compete in Wakefest Hong Kong using IWWF's Event Management System (EMS) (https://ems.iwwf.sport/) no later than 20 Oct 2025. An entry is considered complete when an athlete has registered for the event in EMS and full entry fee payment has been received. Entry fee payment must be made through the individual form.

The procedure for your Federation to register in EMS is as follows:

- 1. Athlete has to login to EMS
- 2. Go to ${\bf My\ Competitions}$ and Click on "New participation" button.

Select the appropriate competition from the list. Filter as follows:

3. Select your category and click on "Submit Participation" button.

- Entry priority will be given to overseas athletes.
- Secondly, a <u>first-come</u>, <u>first-served basis</u> will be used to fill up the remaining quota for each category.
- All remaining applications will go through a random draw to determine the final athletes lists.
- The organizer reserves the right to accept or reject, amend the quota for each group, the number of categories and the heat system as deemed necessary.
- The organizer reserves the right to close a category if there are less than 3 participants.
- All overseas athletes must provide evidence of personal accident insurance for the competition & send a copy of the cover note to info@waterski.org.hk 7 days before the event. Participation in the event will not be permitted without adequate cover.

Wakesurf Format & Scoring	Individual (Wakesurf) Each judge will award a maximum of 40 points to each athlete based on their overall impressions of the route performed. Each individual heat per division will be judged independently from the other heats on the day. The judges will score the first rider of the heat subjectively and each subsequent athletes' performance after that rider is judged higher or lower dependent on their ride. The judges will score each rider in each of the following categories: Wakesurf: Execution - 1-10 Points; Intensity - 1-10 Points; Difficulty - 1-10 Points; Variety - 1-10 Points (scoring can be in increments of .10)				
Wakesurf Restrictions:	*For the Trick Restrictions, please refer to the section headed "Wakesurf Rules" above. If a restricted trick is performed, it will not be counted. **If the registration number is excessive, HKCWA has the right to make amendments on the quota for each group, the number of categories and the heat system. **** Age as of 31st December of the event year for determining the age category. ***** A rider can choose to compete in both disciplines, surf and skim. Riders must use the appropriate board when competing in either discipline. i.e must use a skim board if entering in skim disciplines. Each wakeboard team consists of up to six riders. The team's overall score is calculated using the top four individual scores from any category. Team members must compete in wakeboard competition.

Wakeboard Team scoring

For the Nautique IWWF Asia Wakefest Hong Kong 2025, the team competition rules are outlined in the bulletin provided below. Please disregard the team competition rules specified in the 2025 IWWF Rule Book.

- a) Each wakeboard team consists of up to six riders. The team's overall score is calculated using the top four individual scores from any category. Team members must compete in wakeboard competition.
- b) All team riders must agree to participate by his/her own decision. Any false application of team rider occur, the team will be disqualified.
- c) Each team rider will be awarded the following points depending on his final placement in his respective category:

1st place 100 points; 2nd place 80 points; 3rd place 65 points; 4th place 55 points;

5th place 45 points: 6th place 35 points: 7th place 30 points: 8th place 25 points:

9th place 20 points; 10th place 17 points; 11th place 14 points; 12th place 11 points;

13th place 8 points; 14th place 6 points; 15th place 5 points; 16th place 4 points;

17th place 3 points; 18th place 2 points; 19th place 1 point;

20th place and all subsequent riders receive 1 point each

With the use of the heat system, there will be instances where riders have finished in a joint position with a rider in a different heat. Relevant placing points will therefore be given to each team rider based on their placement in the heat and seeding.

- d) In the event that a category does not have a minimum of 6 riders, the category will still proceed, but points will be calculated as below:
- 3 riders = 50% of the standard score
- 4 riders = 67% of the standard score
- 5 riders = 83% of the standard score
- 6 riders or more 100% of the standard score
- e) In the event of a tie, the final team placement will be determined by the highest number of first-place finishes (champions). If a tie persists, the greatest number of second-place finishes will be used to determine the final placement and so forth. Should a tie still remain, priority will be determined based on the number of participants entered in the following categories, with greater weight assigned in this order: Open > Junior > Masters > Advance > Intermediate > Novice, until a winner is established.
- f) If a team rider is disqualified for unsportsmanlike conduct (except in cases where the disqualification is due to arriving late to the dock or not wearing a bib), no team points will be awarded for that rider. No substitutions will be permitted.
- g) Only sick leave will be accepted as a valid reason for substituting team riders; no other reasons will be permitted. The revised team list must be submitted to the organizer or Chief Judge before the start of the competition.
- h) The top three winning teams must remain for podium pictures; otherwise, they may forfeit any prizes or awards.
- All judges' decisions are final.

	With the use of the heat system, there will be instances where riders have finished in a joint position with a rider in a different heat. Relevant placing points will therefore be given to each team rider based on their placement in the heat and seeding.
	d) In the event that a category does not have a minimum of 6 riders, the category will still proceed, but points will be calculated as below: 3 riders = 50% of the standard score 4 riders = 67% of the standard score 5 riders = 83% of the standard score 6 riders or more 100% of the standard score
	e) In the event of a tie, the final team placement will be determined by the highest number of first-place finishes (champions). If a tie persists, the greatest number of second-place finishes will be used to determine the final placement and so forth. Should a tie still remain, priority will be determined based on the number of participants entered in the following categories, with greater weight assigned in this order: Open > Junior > Masters > Amateurs > Beginners, until a winner is established.
	f) If an individual participates in more than one category (e.g., Open Men Skim and Master Men Surf), they may choose to apply both enrollments toward the same team, occupying two of the six scoring slots on that team. Alternatively, they may split their two enrollments to represent two different teams separately, with their Open Men Skim score counting toward one team and their Master Men Surf score counting toward another team. This decision must be finalized during team enrollment, and no changes















will be allowed afterward.

- g) If a team rider is disqualified for unsportsmanlike conduct (except in cases where the disqualification is due to arriving late to the dock or not wearing a bib), no team points will be awarded for that rider. No substitutions will be permitted.
- h) Only sick leave will be accepted as a valid reason for substituting team riders; no other reasons will be permitted. The revised team list must be submitted to the organizer or Chief Judge before the start of the competition.
- i) The top three winning teams must remain for podium pictures; otherwise, they may forfeit any prizes or awards.

All judges' decisions are final.

- All entries to be confirmed upon receipt of payment.
- All judges' decisions are final.
- Event categories and schedules may be adjusted at the Organiser's discretion depending on weather, time and participant numbers.
- All overseas athletes must provide evidence of personal accident insurance for the competition & send a copy of the cover note to info@waterski.org.hk 7days before the event. Participation in the event will not be permitted without adequate cover.
- All athletes must attend the judging briefing; otherwise they may not be allowed to ride.
- Team registration for the Open (other than for overseas teams) should ideally be supported by a HKCWA registered coach. Results may be taken into consideration in the HKCWA annual coaching awards. Team Entry Fee is \$1000.
- By participating in the event athletes agree that the HKCWA may publish their name and image(s) in any material including official results and rankings and press releases without restraint.

During the competition & at the competition venue:

- No one is allowed to climb over the fence.
- No one can enter the water, except when it is their turn to compete. The pontoon at Shing Fung Road Park is for access only. No vessels should moor alongside other than competition boats.
- No smoking, alcohol or dogs/cats (pets) are allowed at the LCSD venue. Violation of the above will
 result in disqualification from the competition immediately and athletes (both individual and team) will
 not be eligible to receive awards.
- Please pay attention and read thoroughly the Hong Kong Regulations Chapter 132 BC PLEASURE GROUNDS REGULATION beforehand.
